The Emsakya application alerts you with times for the daily prayer, Suhour and Iftar during the Holy Month of Ramadan.

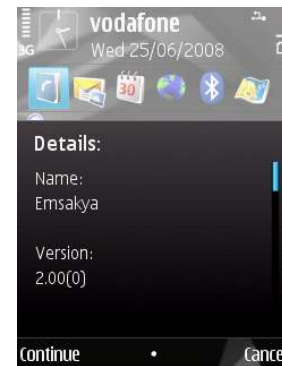
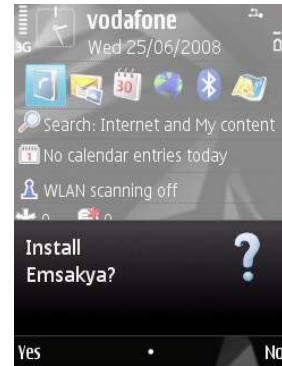
Main Features:

- Friendly and comfortable user interface that conveys the Arabic and Islamic look and feel.
 - Prayer times for most locations all over the world covering all known calculation methods.
 - Selective prayer alert for the daily five prayers.
 - Daily Suhour and Fasting alarms.
 - Online update for the beginning of Ramadan and the Eid dates.
 - Supporting four UI and content languages (English, Arabic, French and Urdu).
- Tip:** Prayer times are estimated through mathematical calculations, and we carefully adjust them to be closer to actual prayer times as much as possible.



Installation:

- Use Nokia PC Suite for installation, or copy the installation package "**Emsakya. Sis**" to your device memory, and then follow the step-by-step installation process.
- Refer to your phone user manual for more information about installing new applications.



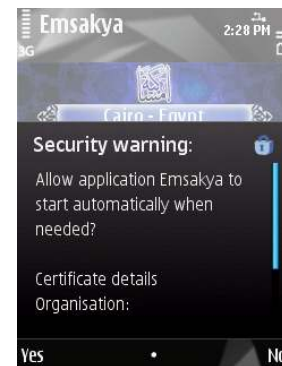
Using the application:

- To run the application, go to "**Menu > Installed > Emsakya**".

1. Main View:

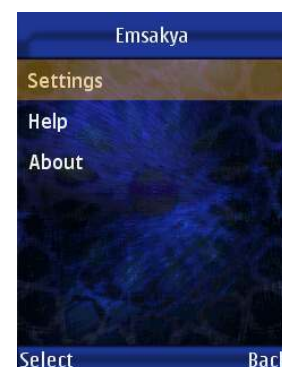
- The main view of the application displays the following items:
 1. The Country and City names that are selected from the Settings.
 2. The Gregorian date and its corresponding Hijri date (only for Ramadan month).
 3. The prayer times for the current day.
- Select "**Exit**" to close the application, and then press "**Yes**" for the confirmation message that will appear.

- ☑ **Tip:** To allow the application to start automatically in order to give the Azan or the Suhoor alarm once it was set before, select "**Yes**" when you see the following message (allow the application "Emsakya" to start when needed) after the exit confirmation message.



2. Main View Options Menu:

- The Main View Options Menu includes the following Options:
 1. Settings.
 2. Help.
 3. About.
- Use up and down arrows to highlight the option that you want to display then press "**Select**" to open it.
- Press "**Back**" to go to the main view.



2.1 Settings:

- The Settings View includes the following Options:
 1. Language setting.
 2. Emsakya settings.



2.1.1 Language setting:

- To change the application's UI language select "**Options > Settings > Language setting**" then choose your preferred language from the following languages: (**Arabic - English – French – Urdu**) and press "**Select**".
- Press "**Back**" to go back to the previous view.



2.1.2 Emsakya settings:

- The Emsakya settings enable the user to set the application through the following options:
 1. Beginning of Ramadan.
 2. Suhoor time.
 3. Calculation Method.
 4. Asr Method.
 5. Time.
 6. Country – City.
 7. Azan options.
 8. Update Eid date.
- Use up and down arrows to highlight the option that you want to display, and then press "**Select**" to open it.
- Press "**Back**" to go back to the previous view.



2.1.2.1 Beginning of Ramadan:

- This option enables the user to set the beginning of Ramadan Month.

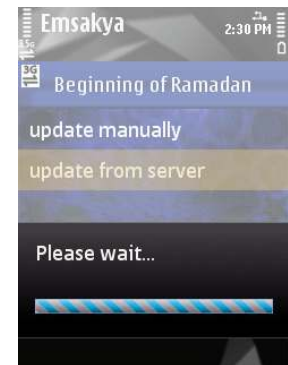
1. update manually:

- By entering the Gregorian date that corresponds to beginning of Ramadan month.

2. update from server:

- Update from server via **GPRS** connection.

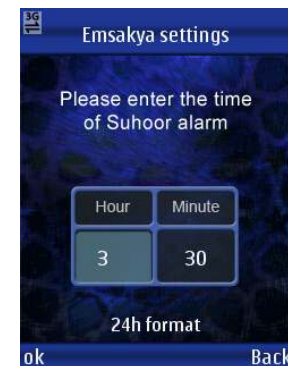
- ☑ **Tip:** You should select "Yes" for the displayed message in order to activate the connection needed to get the updates. If you selected "No", you will have to restart the application to activate it again.



2.1.2.2 Suhoor time:

- This option enables the user to set the alarm time for the Suhoor.

- ☑ **Tip:** The user can only add the Suhoor time to be after the Isha Prayer and until before the Fajr prayer.



2.1.2.3 Calculation Method:

- This option enables the user to select the prayer calculation method that his country follows.

- The different calculation methods are:

1. Um ul-qura, Makkah.
2. Egyptian Authority.
3. Karachiani.
4. North American.
5. World Islamic League.



2.1.2.4 Asr Method:

- This option enables the user to select the Asr method that his country follows.
- The different Asr methods are:
 1. Standard.
 2. Hanafi.



2.1.2.5 Time:

- This option enables the user to select whether to observe the daylight saving or not, by choosing one of the following options:
 1. Summer Time.
 2. Winter Time.



2.1.2.6 Country – City:

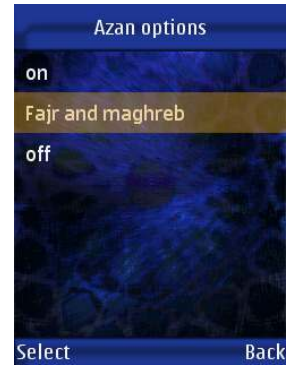
- This option enables the user to select his country and city.



2.1.2.7 Azan options:

- This option enables the user to activate or deactivate the Azan feature by choosing any of the following options:
 1. On.
 2. Fajr and Maghreb.
 3. Off.

☑ **Tip:** The default value for Azan options is Fajr and Maghreb.



2.1.2.8 update Eid date:

- This option enables the user to set the Eid date:

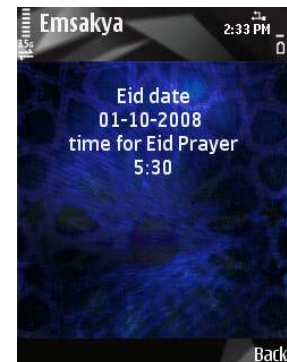
1. update manually:

2. update from server:

- Update from server via **GPRS** connection.

☑ **Tip:** You should select "Yes" for the displayed message in order to activate the connection needed to get the updates. If you selected "No", you will have to restart the application to activate it again.



2.2 Help:

- It displays the application features and how to use them.
- To display the help at any time, select "**Options >Help**".



2.3 About:

- It displays information about the application and the developer (version – copyright – company name and email).
- To display this information at any time, select "**Options > About**".
