

Recycle your old mobile phone, battery and charger.

No stamp required
if posted in Australia

It's simple. Do it now.

1. Place your old mobile phone/s **including battery still connected to handset/s** into a box or envelope. Put any old chargers and/or accessories in a bag before putting them into the box or envelope with the handset so they are separated from the handsets.
2. If you are only recycling a mobile phone battery/ies without a handset/s **please wrap the battery/ies separately in bubble wrap or similar** and seal before putting in box or envelope. Each battery must be **completely enclosed** in inner packaging so it does not come in contact with anything else in the box or envelope including chargers and accessories.
3. Seal the box/envelope and fill out the details below.
4. Read and sign Sender's Declaration.
5. Drop it in the post for free anywhere in Australia.

Mobile phone batteries, chargers and accessories are all accepted.

MobileMuster is the official recycling program of the Mobile Phone industry and run as a not-for-profit program. All recycling of components is to the highest environmental standards. None of the mobiles are sold for reuse.

Sender's Declaration

I, the sender, declare that:

1. If I am sending a handset/s and battery/ies, the battery/ies is/are still connected to the handset/s.
2. I have separated the accessories (chargers etc) from the handset/s.
3. If I am sending a battery/ies without a handset/s the battery/ies is/are packaged in accordance with instructions above.
4. I have sealed the envelope/box.
5. I have completed the sender's details.
