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# Settings wizard

## About Settings wizard

Settings wizard configures your device for network service provider, e-mail, push to talk, and video sharing settings based on your service provider information. The availability of different settings depends on the features of your device, SIM card, network service provider, and availability of the data in the Settings wizard database in the device memory.

To use these services, you may have to contact your service provider to activate a data connection or other services.

## First start-up

When you use Settings wizard for the first time, you are guided through the settings configuration.

To start the wizard after using it for the first time, select the settings you want to configure and **Start**.

If you do not have a SIM card inserted, you are asked to select your network service provider and their home country. If the suggested country or network service provider is not the correct one, select one from the list.

To access the main view of Settings wizard after the settings configuration, select **OK**. If the settings configuration is interrupted, the settings are not defined. After closing the wizard, you can start to use the configured applications in their own menu locations.

## Configure settings

### E-mail settings

To add a new or activate an existing mailbox, Settings wizard asks you to enter an e-mail address, mailbox type and name, user name, and password.

### Network service provider settings

If you choose to configure your network service provider settings, such as MMS and WAP settings, Settings wizard asks you to select from the available settings. Select the relevant settings and **OK**.

## Push to talk settings

This option is available only if you have the application installed in your device and you have subscribed to the service.

If you choose to configure your push to talk (PTT) (network service) settings, Settings wizard asks you to define your PTT nickname, user name, and password.

## Video sharing settings

This option is available only if you have the application installed in your device and you have subscribed to the service.

To make a video call, you must have a USIM card inserted in your device and be in coverage of a UMTS network.

If you choose to configure your video sharing (network service) settings, Settings wizard asks you to enter a video sharing address, user name, password, user name for the video sharing proxy, and password. Select **OK**. To add the video sharing address to a contact, after creating video sharing settings, select the contact and **Yes**.
